

Topic: Beyond IIPP, Behavioral Based Safety (BBS) and Job Hazard Analysis (JHA) Tools

When properly utilized, Behavioral Based Safety (BBS) does much towards heightening employee safety awareness. For supervisors this provides opportunity to encourage employee use of safe work methods, and for employees, knowing what is expected from them to safely perform their job tasks. Prior to any job start, Job Hazard Analysis (JHA) provides a pre-job safety means for identifying and mitigating loss potential. This session will introduce sample BBS and JHA tools that can be easily tailored for use, and will conclude with an interactive demonstration to complete a JHA.
