Mr. Steven Bowers has over 32 years of experience as an Environmental, Health & Safety Professional in the Petrochemical, Semiconductor Manufacturing and Construction Industries.

Mr. Bowers spent 20 years working as a Safety Professional in the petrochemical industry during 1970's & 80's developing industry leading safety programs designed to eliminate injuries and incidents.

In 1995 Mr. Bowers assumed responsibility for overseeing the Environmental, Health and Safety program for all of Intel Corporations construction projects worldwide. On average, these were \$2-\$3 billion worth of projects each year, located in ~20 countries. During Mr. Bowers' tenure, Intel achieved industry leading, World Class Safety Performance (RIR <1) in 1999 and sustained that performance through his departure in 2005. Mr. Bowers left his former position as Worldwide Construction Safety Manager at Intel Corp. to form Global Safety Management Consultants, a San Ramon, CA based Environmental, Health & Safety consulting firm.

As President of Global Safety Management Consultants, Steve has developed a series of Safety Management and Leadership workshops that focus on mentoring clients on how to create World Class Safety Cultures within their organizations. The firm's unique **L²IFE (Leading and Living Injury Free Everyday)** safety management system is a holistic program which drives safety leadership, engagement, commitment and ownership through all levels of an organization. This focus on safety performance begins with enhancing leadership attributes at the management level and then throughout the organization. Through use of a unique mixture of cultural development tools, organizations can dramatically reduce workers compensation costs, enable healthier & more productive employees and create a safety culture where both employees and the bottom line, thrive.

Mr. Bowers has given many key note addresses and presentations on various safety topics including "The Journey to World Class Safety Performance" for ENR in China and Denmark, as well as in the US for the Construction Industry Institute, Construction Users Roundtable, Fiatch and many others.
