Surprise inspections by regulatory agencies can bring costly fines if your business is not prepared. To help you be prepared, State Fund has partnered with the Economic and Employment Enforcement Coalition (EEEC) to inform you about current laws and regulations in the construction industry.

The EEEEC is a labor, employment, and licensing law enforcement unit that conducts unannounced inspections for labor law and health and safety violations. One of the industries the EEEEC is currently targeting is construction businesses.

The EEEEC is comprised of investigators and inspectors from the:

- Labor Commissioner's Office
- Cal/OSHA
- Employment Development Department (EDD)
- Contractors State License Board (CSLB)
- U.S. Department of Labor (DOL)

Join us for a unique opportunity to learn more about the EEEEC, to clarify your rights and responsibilities under state law, and to ask questions of representatives from the collective agencies.
