**Take 680 South toward Walnut Creek  
Exit Treat Boulevard / Geary Road  
Turn Left from offramp at 1<sup>st</sup> stoplight  
Turn Left at next stoplight onto Treat Boulevard  
Straight on Treat Boulevard  
The Fire Station is on your left side, marked by the U.S. and California flags  
Turn Left before Oak Grove Boulevard, into the Fire District Training Center  
Arrive at 2945 Treat Boulevard, Concord**

**Take 680 North past Walnut Creek  
Exit Treat Boulevard  
Right onto Treat Boulevard  
Straight on Treat Boulevard  
You will see the Fire Station on your left side, marked by the U.S. and California flags  
Turn Left before Oak Grove Boulevard, into the Fire District Training Center  
Arrive at 2945 Treat Boulevard, Concord**
