*Operating forklifts, tractors and other equipment on hillsides and uneven terrain; pushing and lifting bins, tubs, barrels, pumps, hoses and mixers in an improper manner; constantly holding or dangling picking knives from strings; entering confined spaces to chemically clean out tanks without the proper training and equipment--these are just a few of the potential hazards faced by workers in vineyards and wineries during the busy harvest season, a season characterized by rushing to get the job done.*
