Mr. Bejar has over 24 years experience in Environmental, Safety and Health compliance. His experience includes 13 years in Emergency Response and Preparedness, Hazardous Materials, Recreation Water Quality, Legislative Analysis and Pollution Prevention. He is an instructor of emergency first responders as well as a state certified CSTI Hazardous Materials First Responder Specialist and Instructor.

This course will include a review of federal and state respirator regulations, annual employee training and fit-testing requirements. He will demonstrate how to conduct a qualitative and quantitative fit-test. He will also discuss respirator selection and the medical evaluation of respirator users.

In the afternoon session Mr. Bejar will discuss procedures for routine respirator inspections and maintenance.
